### What is new in 2020?

The NASCE Annual Business Meeting will have a new format this year. These data will then be collected each year from the accredited centers and archived. The new format of presentations of each center will have to include the following topics during NASCE Business Meetings:

- New training modalities or approaches performed in the accredited center
- Research & Development activities of each center

Presenting these topics during NASCE Business Meetings will also enable NASCE accredited centers to perform multi-centric studies.

Another new activity of NASCE will be the "NASCE Train the Simulation Technician Course", which will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020 at CASE in Istanbul.



Train the Simulation Technician Course

This course will have two certification levels and will cover following topics:

# Certification Type A (2ndApril 2020)

- Designing the learning environment for medical simulation according to the needs of educators.
- Designing the center according physical and infrastructural requirements.
- Infrastructural requirements of medical equipment and simulators.
- Infrastructural requirements of AV solutions and data network.
- Basic information of sensor technologies used in medical simulation.
- Other components used in medical simulators.
- Storage conditions of simulation systems.
- Preventive maintenance.
- Various operating systems embedded in simulation systems.
- Topology of LMS systems integrated with AV solutions.
- Serious gaming modules used with tablet PC, VR and AR based platforms.
- Hands-on workshop with sensor technologies used in simulators.

# Certification Type B (3rd April 2020)

- Swine Anatomy
- Animal Care in wet lab conditions
- Designing the wet lab according physical, infrastructural and animal welfare requirements
- Animal preparation & operation process
- Sterilization and disinfection procedures

- Types of cadavers used for medical trainings
- Cadaver storage techniques

Course participants can either choose to apply for both certifications or for one of these certifications and attend the course only for one of the certifications.
